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appropriate words, adhering, at least verbally, to all of the fine principles that are supposed to uplift and ennoble a society, but then not practice those things themselves. The question that should be asked is, if it's not good enough for you, if you who understand it, if you who teach and preach it do not think it's good enough to be practiced in your life, how can you go out and recommend it to others? It's very easy. Not only hypocrisy, but the tendency to create a line of division between what a person says he or she believes and what a person does winds up being the practice, especially of people who proclaim themselves deeply religious, or who follow the politicians profession. That means that as long as you can fool the public, your job is done. The only thing to do is to stay in the Legislature. And why do you stay in the Legislature? In order that you may stay in the Legislature. That becomes an end in itself. But I don't believe that's what we ought to be about. I don't believe that the Legislature should just ride with the tide and go with the flow. There are times the Legislature will have to dam the tide and say to the waters, this far you will come and no farther. The Legislature has that job. The Legislature has the means to do that. When we are aware that our fellow citizens, that our brothers and sisters are in squalor and poverty, while we fare sumptuously every...

SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...day, we should try to recapture just a small amount of what it was that moved us when we were very young, before we became jaded, before we became hypocrites, before we became totally disillusioned and decided that the best thing to do is to get as much as I can and to Hades with the hindmost. We have a better job to do than the one we've done thus far. I'm going to help all I can to see that we do it.
