SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. I'd like to welcome all of you to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This is our thirty-first day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Very pleased to have with us this morning, from Senator Hilgert's district in Omaha, the Castelar United Presbyterian Church, we have Pastor Peter MacFarlane.

PASTOR MACFARLANE: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you very much. Members, please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections this morning, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Are there any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Enrollment and Review reports (LB) 114A and LR 13CA to Select File. Enrollment and Review also reports LB 28, (LB) 85, (LB) 86, (LB) 86A, (LB) 97, (LB) 206...I'm sorry, (LB) 206, (LB) 221, (LB) 238, (LB) 342, (LB) 346, (LB) 441, (LB) 489, and LR 32CA as correctly engrossed. Those reports all signed by Senator Bruning. New resolutions. (Read brief summary of LR 81-82.) Both those will be laid over. I have a gubernatorial appointment to the Public Employees Retirement Board. That will be referred to Reference for referral to standing committee for confirmation hearing. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 784-87 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. I would announce that a slight adjustment to today's schedule. LB 887 was scheduled to be the first bill on special order this morning. The principle introducer is unavoidably detained this morning, so we will be passing over that bill momentarily. When Senator Wehbein arrives, we will be slipping that back into the agenda. So, it
