SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This is the thirty-second day, Thursday, February 27, 1997, of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain for the day is our own Harland Johnson. Harland.
