PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK:     Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Jim Voss of Rosemont Alliance Church, here in Lincoln. Pastor Voss.
