PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Witek.

SENATOR WITEK: Madam Chair, members of the body, I apologize if we're leaving at eleven, but I did want to give Senator Pedersen some support for this amendment. I have also talked to probation officers who would like to have these plates. Senator Chambers, I understand you're trying to make it sound like it's an unnecessary thing. But those individuals who are in the field are telling us it is necessary. And I would rather give them whatever tool they think is necessary to perform their job safely, and would vote for Senator Pedersen's amendment and encourage the rest of the senators to do so.
