by SIDs. And that's simply the bill. I have an amendment. I'd like to add the emergency clause simply because we're getting into the construction period, and so if this is passed it can be used this year. So the emergency clause is the amendment, is the committee amendments. Mr. Speaker.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Okay. Senator Hartnett, was that your opening both on the bill and the committee...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah, yeah.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: ...and the committee amendment?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah, yeah.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Is there any discussion on the committee amendment? I see no discussion on the committee amendment. Senator Hartnett waives closing on the committee amendment. The question before the body is, shall the committee amendment to LB 589 be adopted? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: The committee amendment is adopted. Is there any discussion on the bill? I see no discussion. Senator Hartnett, do you wish to close?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Would simply restate again what it does. It allows SIDs to spend money outside their district in cooperation with cities or counties. It has to be a cooperative agreement between the two bodies. So that's all the bill does, and I explained it earlier. So I'd ask for the advancement of LB 589.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: You've heard the closing from Senator Hartnett. The issue is, shall LB 589 be advanced? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.
