SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator Chambers. There are no other lights on. Senator Bruning.

SENATOR BRUNING: Mr. President, I move to advance LB 466 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR LANDIS: You've heard the motion. Those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, (LB) 284. No E & R. Senator Beutler would move to amend the bill. (See AM1119 on page 1133 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Beutler, on your amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Landis, members of the Legislature, certain parties, specifically bankers, are interested in having an emergency clause on this particular provision, and it seems like a good idea to me. And so, unless there's objection, I would ask that the emergency clause be attached.

SENATOR LANDIS: There are no other lights. Senator Beutler waives closing. The question is the adoption of the E clause. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Thank you. Mr. Clerk, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. The amendment is adopted. Senator Bruning.

SENATOR BRUNING: I move LB 284 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR LANDIS: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The motion is carried. Mr. Clerk.
