ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 153 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 153 pass? All in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as seen on page 1156 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is: 42 ayes, 1 nay, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 153 passes. We will now return to the reading of LB 103, followed by the reading of LB 128.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 103 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 103 pass? All of those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to vote? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as seen on page 1157 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 15 ayes, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 103 passes. Mr. Clerk, LB 128.

CLERK: (Read LB 128 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 128 pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to vote? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as seen on pages 1157-58 of the Legislative Journal.) 35 ayes, 4 nays, 5 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting. Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 128 does pass with the emergency clause attached. The next order of business is to vote on whether the at-large reading of LB 62 should be suspended. All in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
