SPEAKER WITHEM: The motion is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, is there anything else pending?

CLERK: I have nothing further pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Would you please read the title to the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 250. A bill for an act introduced by the General Affairs Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 250 pass? All of those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1160 of the Legislative Journal.) 39 ayes, 5 nays, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 250 passes. Next motion will be...or the next vote will be on suspending at-large reading on LB 469. All in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the dispensing with Final Reading.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Mr. Clerk, please read the title.

CLERK: LB 469. Introduced by Senators Schellpeper, Coordsen, Cudaback, Jones, Vrtiska, and Wickersham. (Read title.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 469 pass?
