SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Good afternoon and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This is the forty-eighth day, Wednesday, March 26, of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Stephanie Alschwede from the Trinity Methodist Church in Lincoln. Pastor.

SENATOR CROSBY: Roll call, will senators please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: One new resolution, LR 104. (Read summary.) That will be referred to the Executive Board.
