I'd appreciate your support. You know what you're going to do. The good thing to do, I believe, is to place this bill on General File, and then get to the debate on the issues that concern people. Only applies to municipalities; doesn't do anything new; codifies decisions. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Senator Will has requested a roll call vote in reverse order. I believe all members not excused are present. Mr. Clerk, proceed to call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken in reverse order. See pages 1247-48 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President, on the motion.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Motion does not pass. Mr. Clerk, are there any messages?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a communication from the Governor to the Clerk. (Read. Re: (LB) 118, (LB) 118A, (LB) 128, (LB) 152, (LB) 486, (LB) 226, (LB) 107, (LB) 153, (LB) 62, (LB) 250, (LB) 469, (LB) 474, (LB) 713, (LB) 809, (LB) 623, and (LB) 720.) I have amendments to be printed by Senator Chambers to (LB) 422; Senator Bromm to (LB) 466; Senator Bohlke to (LB) 303. Senator Coordsen would like to withdraw his motion filed earlier on (LB) 519.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Are there any objections to the withdrawal of the motion? Did I hear an objection? I did not. There is no objection, so ordered.

CLERK: I have a request to add Senator Will's name to (LB) 401, Senator Maurstad to (LB) 776, Senator Dwite Pedersen to (LB) 401. And, Mr. President, a reminder that the Natural Resources Committee will have an Executive Session tomorrow at nine o'clock. Mr. President, I have a priority motion. Senator Hilgert would move to adjourn until March 27 at 12:00 noon.
