CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President,...

SENATOR WILL: The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Transportation reports: LB 353 to General File; (LB) 881, General File with amendments; (LB) 402, (LB) 445, (LB) 463, (LB) 697, (LB) 698, (LB) 827, (LB) 880, indefinitely postponed. (LB 399 also indefinitely postponed.) The Revenue Committee reports: (LB) 269, (LB) 271, (LB) 306, and (LB) 804 to General File with committee amendments attached. Revenue Committee also reports, Mr. President, LB 84 to General File, and LR 37 to General File. Enrollment and Review reports LB 476, (LB) 452, (LB) 555, (LB) 740, (LB) 523, (LB) 424, (LB) 193, (LB) 643, (LB) 873 to Select File, some of which have Enrollment and Review amendments attached. And a new resolution, Mr. President. (Read brief summary of LR 107.) That's all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 1303-08 of the Legislative Journal.)
