CLERK:     Senator Landis would move to amend with AM1130, Mr. President. (AM1130 appears on page 1300 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM:    Senator Landis, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS:    Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Because of some recent congressional action, the bill needs to become law on July 31, 1997, to coincide with these new federal law changes as well. That's what the amendment does, and I offer it at this time. An operative date of July 31, 1997.

SPEAKER WITHEM:    You've heard the opening on the amendment. Any discussion? Seeing none. Is there a closing? Closing is waived. The question is the adoption of the Landis amendment, AM1130. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK:     25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Landis' amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM:    The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK:     Nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM:    Senator Landis waives closing. The question is, shall LB 335 be advanced? All of those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK:     26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 335.

SPEAKER WITHEM:    LB 335 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 741.

CLERK:     (LB) 741, by Senator Landis. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 22, referred to the Banking Committee, advanced to General File.

SPEAKER WITHEM:    Senator Landis.
