This doesn't give the total picture in the sense that the Game Fund will be reimbursed somewhere between forty and fifty thousand dollars of federal funds as this program proceeds. So, the outlay is really, at the state level, somewhere around between twenty and thirty thousand dollars. But for purposes of the appropriation, this is what is necessary. Thank you.

SENATOR DIERKS:        Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature. LB 577A is the appropriation for...provides the appropriation for LB 577, which was the Rural Health Systems Professional Incentive Act, which we are going to amend. It calls for \$50,000 from the General Fund on the Fiscal Year '97-'98, and \$100,000 on '98-'99. This is to provide for incentives for medical...certain medical personnel to practice in rural areas. I'd appreciate the support for the amendment...or for the bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM:        Senator, there are no lights on. Do you have a closing? Closing is waived. The question is, shall LB 577A be advanced? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
