SENATOR KRISTENSEN: If you're going to put something on the special election, you're going to need 40 votes.

SENATOR DIERKS: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you. Senator Kristensen, there are no other lights on, did you wish to say anything in closing on your motion to return to Select File for the specific amendment?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, I do. I just want to respond to Senator Jones. Senator Jones, I got a chance to look up here, in 1972, in the general election, 15 and...no, excuse me, 13 of the 15...13 of the 16 passed, the only ones that went down were paying legislators, giving them retirement systems, and a Board of Equalization change. So the voters did pick and choose, obviously they found the people they didn't necessarily care for and voted against those amendments for pay raises, per diems, and Board of Equalization. I would urge again, for those who are just coming in, this is to add the amendment that would hold this election in the May primary to a special election of 1998.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you. You heard the closing. The motion before the body is to return LB 32CA (sic) to Select File for the purposes of a specific amendment. All in favor please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR COORDSEN: We are on Select File with LB 32CA (sic). We have AM1310. Senator Kristensen, did you wish to say anything further on your amendment?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: No, I would move the amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: You heard the motion. Motion is to adopt an amendment to...no, it's a board...machine vote...1310 to LR 32CA. All in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
