SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Ladies and Gentlemen, welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. As we begin today, the fifty-seventh day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session, very pleased to have with us Pastor Allen Myers from Piedmont Park Seventh Day Adventist Church, here in Lincoln.

PASTOR ALLEN MYERS: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you very much, Pastor. Members, please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Quorum is present. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any reports or announcements or messages?

CLERK: Your Committee...your committee on Enrollment and Review reports LR 17 and LR 20 as correctly engrossed. (See page 1490-91 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. I have an announcement. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I would propose to sign and do sign LR 106, (LR) 107, (LR) 109, (LR) 111, (LR) 112, and (LR) 113. Mr. Clerk, first bill on General File.

CLERK: Mr. President, (LB) 875 introduced by the Urban Affairs Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 22 of this year. At that time, it was referred to the Revenue Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments, Mr. President. (See AM0963 found on page 1090 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Hartnett, to open on the bill.
