CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 852A.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 852A advances. LB 853A.

CLERK: (LB) 853A by Senator Will. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Will to open on the bill.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. LB 853A reflects an amendment that was adopted on LB 853, I believe, on Select File regarding the Workers' Compensation Court and the compensation for those judges. It appropriates approximately \$27,000 from the Cash Fund that funds the Compensation Court. It simply would reflect the amendment that was adopted. It is entirely cash funded. I would ask for its advancement.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Will. Any discussion on the advancement of LB 853A? Seeing none, Senator Will to close. Closing is waived. The question before you is the advancement of LB 853A. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 853A.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 853A passes. LB 861A.

CLERK: (LB) 861A by Senator Chambers. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers to open on the bill.
