SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is withdrawn. Any discussion on the committee amendments and/or the bill? Seeing none, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. I'd ask for adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 608? All in favor, vote aye, opposed, no. Record, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CROSBY: The committee amendments are adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk? Senator Wesely, there are no lights. Would you like to close.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes. Madam President, members, first off I want to thank Senator Brown for her assistance. I know she had an amendment she would have liked to have offered, but it would have probably killed the bill. It's important to pass the bill, and I thank her for her cooperation. The bill will deal with an evolving area right now in the assisted living field as that we age, we're seeing more and more interest in providing assisted living to our older population. In addition, we...as we institutionalize, we're going to see more individuals needing these types of facilities, so it's important to have a good oversight, and a reasonable oversight. This bill will help with that. I ask for your support. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Wesely. You've heard the closing. The question is the advancement of LB 608. All in favor, vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of (LB) 608.
