SENATOR CROSBY: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do see five hands. The question is, shall debate cease? All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on ceasing debate. We're voting on ceasing debate. Have you all voted? We're voting on ceasing debate. Record, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.

SENATOR CROSBY: No objections? It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Stuhr, this is AM1626. Senator, I have note you want to withdraw that?

SENATOR CROSBY: No objections? The Stuhr amendment is withdrawn.
