schools. I think the others could probably live with it, but I think it's very important that we have intent language. And...because if we don't have intent language, what would be...it would be into May, or not May, but into March before we would actually come out and say how much money each of the areas of the subdivisions would get out of the 100 million, and say it is...saying it is 100 million.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Unless we acted...

SENATOR ROBINSON: Would I be correct on that?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Well, if you've got the money...

SENATOR ROBINSON: Because wouldn't it be out of the...wouldn't it be out of the Appropriations Committee...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: We wouldn't make it an appropriations bill. Senator Coordsen's concept is you put it into this trust fund, and what you're going to do is have a bill then that would authorize the transfer out. That wouldn't be in the budget necessarily, I think that would be a transfer.

SENATOR ROBINSON: So if you did that, you could do that as soon as that bill passed then.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I think that's the...yes, that's the...

SENATOR ROBINSON: So you could do...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: That's the concept of doing that.

SENATOR ROBINSON: So you could even do that in January, is that correct? Would that be right?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Well, there...that's up for discussion, but that's, that's one of the options that have been explored to do that with, find that mechanism to do that with.
