The direction of the partnership is such that there will be more and more consolidation of authority and the Foster Care Review Board will be called upon to do its function, and it will need the services of a program coordinator to assist in that. With that, it looks to me like there are three people that are gone, not present. I'm in the face of a hostile Appropriations Committee. It's kind of a...hmm. It's kind of a low number to use. Why don't we wait for just a minute and, if we could, have the Chair try to solicit our two remaining votes and then go to a machine vote.

SENATOR WILL: Time. We are still looking for Senators Abboud and Robak. Senator Abboud, Senator Robak, please report to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Senator Abboud and Senator Robak, please report to the Chamber.

SENATOR LANDIS: (Microphone not activated immediately)...with a machine vote in this case. The body's time is of value and let's go to a vote.

SENATOR WILL: I understand you wish to proceed, Senator Landis? The question before the body is the adoption of the Landis amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Voting on the Landis amendment to the committee amendment. Have you all voted? Please vote if you care to on the Landis amendment. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: (Microphone not activated immediately)...ask for a roll call....

SENATOR WILL: A roll call vote has been requested. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1891 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 11 nays on the amendment.
