SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 724A to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. That concludes...that will conclude consent calendar for this morning. We will now go to the blue sheet, Select File, LB 660A. Did you have.... Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

SENATOR BRUNING: Madam President, I move we advance LB 660A to E & R for engrossing.
