SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Are there items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, there are, thank you. Appropriations Committee reports LB 394 to General File with amendments. Enrollment and Review reports (LB) 229A, (LB) 523A, (LB) 660A, (LB) 852A, and (LB) 861A as correctly engrossed. Enrollment and Review reports (LB) 401 to Select File, and I have a Senator Stuhr amendment to (LB) 806; a series of amendments from Senator Chambers to LB 890. (See pages 1986-91 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, with respect to (LB) 389, the first item is consideration of Enrollment and Review amendments.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I would recognize...Senator Bruning is not here. Senator Wehrbein, would you handle the E & R amendments, please.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. Speaker, members, I move the E & R amendments on LB 389.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments vote aye or say aye. Those opposed. They are adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment to the bill is by Senator Hilgert. Senator, AM1973. (See page 1870 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator Hilgert, you're recognized to open on this amendment.

SENATOR HILGERT: Mr. Speaker, I'd like to substitute the subsequent amendment under my name for this one.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator Hilgert, are you finding the one that you want?

SENATOR HILGERT: Yeah, I'd like to substitute 1973 with 2153.
