SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the closing. The question now is the adoption...oh, excuse me, we are still under call and we do not have all members checked in so, members, who have not excused themselves need to be in their seats on the floor. Senator Bromm. Senator Jones, Senator Wickersham and Senator Bromm. All members not excused are present. The question now is the adoption of the Dwite Pedersen amendment to the Wehrbein amendment. All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 34 ayes, 1 nay, on the adoption of Senator Dwite Pedersen's amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. The call is raised. Mr. Clerk, next item. Back then to the Wehrbein amendment. We'll recognize the speakers whose lights are on, in their order, for addressing comments on the Wehrbein amendment. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, as I stated earlier, I'm going to support the addition of the Wehrbein amendment to this bill. As a matter of fact, I've signed on to the amendment, but I want to mention something else that I'm considering doing. Since we so overwhelmingly have voted for this money, when we get to LB 389, I'm going to have drafted an amendment to return 389 and add this money to the Corrections budget in that bill, because I don't know what's...I mean, I know what LB 150 is going to go through, but I don't know what the ultimate outcome would be. And in the same way that I took some money out of...it would have gone into LB 150 and been debated with the rest of the this, but it had to do with some operating expense money that is needed currently. I drafted an amendment to put that money back in LB 389 so that nothing is in 150 except the Corrections matter. Since Senator Pedersen's amendment for the paltry amount of a hundred and whatever something thousand dollars it is has been overwhelmingly adopted, I would like to see that made a part of the appropriations bill, and I'm going to attempt to do that. But in the meantime, I support this amendment that Senator
