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LB 590A, 590

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: No, it won't...

SENATOR WITEK: ...and then we're going to take that money and give it to the private entity again, so they'll be getting...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: No, Senator.

SENATOR WITEK: ...twice the...?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: No, let's back up. Let's back up and take it a step at a time. First step is that, yes, you're going to raise the fee under 590, not under the A bill but under 590, you're raising that \$1 for the hard copy to obtain uniformity of the fee. Mean, that's been a problem. Everybody says why should...

SENATOR WITEK: But I want to know what we need the million dollars for.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Oh, oh, we're going...we're going a step at a time, okay?

SENATOR WITEK: Okay.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Now the next step is that does...that fee increase in and of itself isn't the entire amount of the A bill. It's...it...I don't have the breakdown of it because you're also unifying the fee from the UCC searches and the Secretary of State's records. That money now...you have to have somebody to run the network, right? It can't run itself, right?

SENATOR WITEK: Right now a private company's running the network.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Right, but we don't have any...

SENATOR WITEK: And not charging us anything, correct?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: No. Well, there it...

SENATOR CROSBY: One minute.
