SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Bruning.

SENATOR BRUNING: Madam President, I move LB 610A to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 610A. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. We will pass over 660A and 851A. (LB) 853A.

CLERK: (LB) 853A, Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Bruning.

SENATOR BRUNING: Madam President, I move LB 853A to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 853A. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. General File, LB 890.

CLERK: Madam President, 890, introduced by the Business and Labor Committee, signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on February 28 of this year, referred to the Business and Labor Committee. The bill was discussed on May 13 and May 14. Amendments to the committee amendments were offered. The committee amendments were adopted. The next amendment I have pending is Senator Chambers'. I believe, Senator, you had opened on this amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, Mr. Clerk, I would like to withdraw all of the amendments that I have pending.

SENATOR CROSBY: No objection. The amendments are withdrawn.

CLERK: Madam President, I have nothing further pending to LB 890.
