

TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY THE CLERK OF THE LEGISLATURE
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LB 150, 389

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, with the discussion that has already taken place and the explanation of the amendment, I will ask that it be adopted.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, Senator Chambers, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to LB 389. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' Select File amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chambers amendment is adopted. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I move that LB 389 be readvanced.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, the question before you is the advancement of LB 389. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. LB 389 advances.

CLERK: Madam President, a priority motion. Senator Wehrbein would move to reconsider the vote taken on Senator Chambers' motion to return for specific amendment, the amendment being AM2252.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Chair recognizes Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Madam Speaker, members, I would like to suggest the body return this bill for another vote on the Life Skill Program. That's the one that Senator Dwite Pedersen introduced originally. Senator Chambers wanted to put it to LB 389. It will also be in LB 150, as I said before. Apparently, I didn't understand the necessity of having in this bill, too. I would like to ask your reconsideration of this vote. We can put it in LB 389. If they are in both bills and they advance, we can do what needs to be do later if that's what it takes because it could possibly be duplicated. I'm not sure where we're headed with that, but at least it will be in LB 389.
