LB 546, 551, 636

SENATOR CROSBY: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 546 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2179-80 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, 7 excused and not voting, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: (LB) 546 passes. (LB) 551.

CLERK: Madam President, 551, Senator Chambers has a motion, but he requests to withdraw.

SENATOR CROSBY: No objections. It is withdrawn.

CLERK: (Read LB 551 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CROSBY: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 551 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2180-81 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting.

SENATOR CROSBY: (LB) 551 passes. (LB) 636.

CLERK: (LB) 636, again, Senator Chambers has a motion to return to withdraw, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: No objections. It is withdrawn.

CLERK: (Read LB 636 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CROSBY: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 636 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2181-82 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 5 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting.
