for Final Reading. Senators, would you please take your seats for Final Reading. We are on Final Reading, at least we're trying. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 344 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CROSBY: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 344, with the emergency clause, pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2186 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting.

SENATOR CROSBY: (LB) 344e passes. We'll pass over 755e. (LB) 256.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 256 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CROSBY: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 256 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2186-87 of the Legislative Journal.) Vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting.

SENATOR CROSBY: (LB) 256 passes. (LB) 256A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 256A on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CROSBY: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 256A pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2187-88 of the Legislative Journal.) Vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting.

SENATOR CROSBY: (LB) 256A passes. LR 17.
