SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 853 become law? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2194 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 853 passes. Mr. Clerk, LB 853A.

CLERK: (Read LB 853A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 853A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2195 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 5 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 853A passes. We'll now move to LB 53. The first question is, shall the at-large reading pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8. be suspended? All in favor of suspending the at-large reading vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 40 ayes, 1 nay to dispense with Final Reading, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Please read the title.

CLERK: (Read LB 53 by title on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 53 pass? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2195-96 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
