SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, I don't think that's your desire, but that's the effect of it.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Well, that's a matter for conjecture. With that, Madam Chair, I would simply ask that we lay the bill over.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. We will...is there any objection? Seeing none. It is so ordered. Items for the record, to begin with.

CLERK: Madam President, thank you for recognizing items. LR 286, by Senator Vrtiska, it's a resolution proposing a gift of land. Pursuant to its introduction, there's a communication from the Speaker directing the resolution to Reference Committee for a referral to Standing Committee for confirmation...or for public hearing, I should say. I have a reference report referring the resolution. Hearing notice from the Transportation Committee. Bills read on Final Reading this morning have been presented to the Governor. (Re: LB 384, LB 385, LB 388, and LB 389.) And I have two amendments from Senator Chambers to LR 7CA to be printed. (See pages 2295-97 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. LB 138.

CLERK: Madam President, 138, first item is Enrollment and Review amendments, consideration thereof.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Bruning.

SENATOR BRUNING: Madam President, I move we advance LB 138 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Bruning.

SENATOR BRUNING: Oh, pardon me. I move we adcpt the E & R amendments for LB 138.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.
