SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Robinson, to close. Closing's waived. Question is, shall LB 764 be advanced to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 764.

SPEAKER WITHEM: (LB) 764 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 460.

CLERK: Mr. President, may I read some items, very quickly?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Oh, I suppose.

CLERK: Thank you. These are really good items, Mr. President. (Laughter)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Please read the items.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a new resolution, LR 287, by Senator Wickersham. And I've got a letter from you saying that's a good resolution. And I have a reference report and two reports, Mr. President, be on file in the Clerk's office. That's all that I have. (See page 2308 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you very much. Mr. Clerk, LB 460.

CLERK: Mr. President, 460, by Senator Robinson. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 16, referred to the Government Committee, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments, Mr. President.
