SENATOR HILLMAN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. I'm sorry, Mr. Kristensen, I'm kind of...or Senator Kristensen, I'm kind of late coming around. I have one short question for you, if I may.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Kristensen, can you respond?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR HILLMAN: When you talk about all campuses with this scholarship, we also have, from the Med Center, a lot of classes that are done via distance learning. Does it make any difference where these classes, how you participate as long as it's from that particular campus?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I think that's right, but you've got to be...if I remember the background of the statute is you've got to be a full-time student.

SENATOR HILLMAN: Yes. And that...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: And as long as you match those requirements, you're an undergrad, then I think that you're eligible and I don't think it matters where you physically are. What counts is the campus that you're taking it from.

SENATOR HILLMAN: Okay. And there are times when the distance learning is per class, but there is like the West Nebraska School of Nursing where you are a full-time student.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: And I think that's also done in cooperation, isn't it, with the Med Center?

SENATOR HILLMAN: Yes, it is.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: So I think that that's, to my understanding.

SENATOR HILLMAN: Thank you.
