PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR BROMM: ...sector hurt. We don't want to see the rural sector hurt. We're in this thing together. The Governor has often described us as one Nebraska. That's a laudable goal. We should be one Nebraska. The adoption of this amendment will be a very, very modest effort, but a very appreciated effort, if you would see fit to adopt this amendment to help bring up at least a few more of the red schools. Thank you, Madam President. I would ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote in regular order.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Bromm, we are on Final Reading so senators...

SENATOR BROMM: We are.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: ...I will ask senators to check in.

CLERK: Mb. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senators, will you please check in. Senator Raikes, Senator Bohlke, Senator Wickersham, Senator Kristensen, Senator Don Pederson, Senator Engel, Senator Schrock, Senator Cudaback, Senator Matzke, Senator Jensen, Senator Beutler, will you check in. Waiting for Senator Jensen. We are waiting for Senator Jensen. The question before the body is the motion to return LB 806 to Select File. Senator Bromm requested a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2419 of the Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 27 nays on the motion to return, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The motion to return fails.
