PRESIDENT ROBAK: The motion is withdrawn. With nothing else on the bill, senators, please be seated. We are on Final Reading. Senators, please be seated. The first vote is to vote to suspend Final Reading, at large reading pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8. All those in favor vote aye. Excuse me, we don't need to do that on this bill. Mr. Clerk, 806A.

CLERK: (Read LB 806A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 806A pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2429 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 6 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 806A passes. We now go to Select File. LB 864A.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Bruning, on LB 864A. Senator Bruning, I am sorry, Senator, I have no amendments to 864A.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Bruning.

SENATOR BRUNING: Madam President, I move LB 864A to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, all those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. LB 864A advances. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LB 660, LB 660A, LB 686, LB 806, and LB 806A. LB 875.

CLERK: Madam President, 875 on Select File. Enrollment and Review amendments were considered and adopted on May 22nd.
