SENATOR MCKENZIE: Senator Chambers, as close as I can detect, we are still working on issues. I don't know if the correct amendment has come down, but people are still talking.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So something is in the works? Thank you. Members of the Legislature, I do hope that these warring factions can bury the hatchet, not in each other's head. And as Rodney King said, can't you all just all get along? Well, the answer to that is "no". So I guess I haven't been much of a peacemaker in this instance, but at least it gave people some time. It provided the opportunity for the rest of us to get a notion of what the issues are and how they might be worked out. But I will be here observing. I've got a little work to do in my office, Senator Witek, but when I'm down there I'll be watching and paying attention. And I hope that the sides can bring something to us that will be understandable, but I hope they won't do it before 9:00 tonight. So you all have plenty of time, and I will stick it out with you. And with that, Mr. President, I will ask for unanimous consent to withdraw my bracket motion.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: We have unanimous consent to withdraw the motion to bracket. Is there objection? Hearing none. The motion is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.
