It's the life skill issue for serving prisoners. It was 145,000 a year, \$290,000. That is in LB 387 (sic) at this point. It's no longer necessary to have in LB 150 so this amendment withdraws that amendment from LB 150 and I would urge your support for that.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Pedersen, to address the Wehrbein amendment.

SENATOR DW. PEDERSEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, nothing more than that Senator Wehrbein's right on and please do support this amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Chair recognizes the right on. Senator Wehrbein, to close on his amendment.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I want to say it should be LB 389, not 387. (LB) 389 was the mainline bill, that's the bill so there's...so everyone understands it's in LB 389. With that, I close.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Wehrbein amendment. All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Wehrbein amendment is adopted. While the Legislature's in session, capable of transacting business, I would propose to sign and do sign LB 49, (LB) 886, (LB) 335, (LB) 396, (LB) 396A, (LB) 424, (LB) 523, (LB) 523A, (LB) 608, (LB) 624, (LB) 658, (LB) 727, (LB) 216, (LB) 386, and (LB) 387. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend with Floor Amendment 330.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Mr. Clerk, amendment 330.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker, what I would like to do is withdraw all of the amendments I have pending and let them be refiled to this bill on Select File.
