CLERK: (Read LB 852A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 852A pass? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2580 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Mr. Clerk, they are waving at the audience and not seeking recognition for voting changes.

CLERK: I...I was confused, Mr. President. 42 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 852A passes. Mr. Clerk, any items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, communication from the Governor. (Read re: LB 94, (LB) 94A, (LB) 136, (LB) 527, (LB) 543, (LB) 558, (LB) 577, (LB) 577A, (LB) 659, (LB) 741, (LB) 758, (LB) 771, (LB) 772, (LB) 802, (LB) 660, (LB) 660A, (LB) 686.) An Attorney General's Opinion to Senator Jones. (Re: (LB) 271.) And Senator Dwite Pedersen, an amendment to LB 150. (See pages 2581-86 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and will sign LB 724, (LB) 724A, and (LB) 852. Now the Chair recognizes...and (LB) 852A. The Chair has a very difficult decision to make at this point, but I would recognize Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Thank you, Mr. President. I would move we recess until 3 o'clock...okay, 1 o'clock this afternoon.

SPEAKER WITHEM: How about 1:30?

SENATOR MCKENZIE: One-thirty, all right.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Should have recognized Senator Will. All those in favor of recessing say aye. Opposed. We are in recess.
