LB 555, 874

CLERK: 41 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to dispense with Final Reading.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Please read the title, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read title of LB 874.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 874 pass with the emergency clause attached? All of those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Members, I know today's agenda has been somewhat confusing so I like to keep you up to date on what is transpiring. As you are awaiting your final decision on LB 874, let me make a couple of announcements. When the last of these bills is completed, that will be LB 855 (sic), 875, and 875A, we will then return back to the list of bills that...that had motions pending on them. The first of those bills is LB 113, authorize the Tax Commissioner; require certain reports by retailers. So I understand that there is an agreement with...between Senator Kristensen and Senator Matzke that if Senator Matzke has not returned from an activity outside of the Chamber that bill will be passed over. If he returns we will take it up. We then go down the list to the next bill that would be eligible to be dealt with is LB 882. At the request of Senator Engel, we will not be taking that bill up today. We then would get to LB 23, which would be, perhaps, the next bill we go to, depending on what happens on LB 113. Following that, I do not know what the fate of LB 229 will be. That has a possibility of either being brought up past for amendment, brought up to be read or passed over. Senator Matzke has returned. And then that will be all of the bills on the Final Reading agenda that can be addressed today. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2597-98 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 874 passes with the emergency clause attached. Mr. Clerk, LB 555. Dispense with Final Reading will be the first vote. All of those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Record.
