SPEAKER WITHEM: Good afternoon, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome back to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Would encourage members to return to the floor as quickly as possible so we can acquire the necessary quorum in order to begin the afternoon deliberation. All of those members who are present please record your presence. (Recorder malfunction) ...meeting this afternoon and we do have some business to transact. For those of you that are in your offices, we do need a quorum here on the floor before we can get started. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: A quorum is present. Mr. Clerk, do you have any items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, just referral of a few study resolutions, Mr. President, that's all that I have. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 2620-21 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. At the request of the introducers, sponsors of LB 150, we'll be passing over that bill for a very short-term basis and moving on to LB 364 at this point. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 364 on Final Reading. I do have motions to return the bill. Senator Brashear, I have AM1723 in front of me with a note you want to withdraw that one, Senator.

SPEAKER WITHEM: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Brashear would move to return the bill for a specific amendment. Senator, AM2653 in front of me at this time.
