vote aye. Opposed nay. With the emergency clause. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2641 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present not voting, 1 excused not voting.

SENATOR BEUTLER: LB 182 passes with the emergency clause. Next bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first request is to dispense with Final Reading on LB 182A.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The question before the body is the motion to suspend the at-large reading of LB 182AE. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 40 ayes, 1 nay to dispense with Final Reading

SENATOR BEUTLER: Read the title, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read title.)

SENATOR BEUTLER: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is whether LB 182AE shall pass. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. With the emergency clause. Don't want them to develop any routine out there. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2642 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present not voting, 1 excused not voting.

SENATOR BEUTLER: LB 182AE passes. Next bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first request is to dispense with Final Reading on LB 197.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The motion before the body is the vote to suspend the at-large reading for LB 197. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 1 nay to dispense with Final Reading,
