SENATOR BRASHEAR:    The amendment to the permanent rules is not adopted. Mr. Clerk. The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may before we proceed, Retirement Committee reports LB 96 and (LB) 147, (LB) 330, (LB) 367, (LB) 491, (LB) 567, (LB) 725, (LB) 639 as indefinitely postponed, 639 is by the Education Committee, the others by Retirement. Jud'ciary reports (LB) 777 to General File. New resolutions, LR 293 by Senator Beutler and (LR) 294 by Senator Withem. I have confirmation report from Health and Human Services Committee. Mr. President, the next item I have is a confirmation report from the Natural Resources Committee.

SENATOR BRASHEAR:    Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President, the Natural Resources Committee reports favorably upon the appointments suggested by the Governor of Dick Mercer and Gail Yanney, both to the Nebraska Environmental Trust Board, and suggests that the appointments be affirmed by the Legislature.
