See page 270 of the Legislative Journal.) 10 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment to the Rules Committee proposal.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is not adopted. The call is raised. We are back to the amendment to Rule 3. Mr. Clerk, did you have any other announcements or things to read into the record, please?

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 1117-1129 by title for the first time. See pages 270-73 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, in addition to those items I have a priority bill designation, LB 1075 by Senator Tyson. And amendments to be printed: Senator Beutler would like to print amendments to LB 656.
