SENATOR BRASHEAR: That's my understanding, under 29-437, that there...

SENATOR ABOUD: Right.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: ...would not be a trial by jury accorded.

SENATOR ABOUD: Okay. All right, I don't have any other questions. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Brown, you're recognized to close on advancement.

SENATOR BROWN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I appreciate the quality of discussion that we've had. I think we have arrived at some issues that Senator Brashear and Senator Chambers and I can work on before Select File. I also appreciate the patience of the body in allowing us to work through some of the intricacies of this. I do believe that this legislation is good policy, I believe that it protects people, I believe that it is in the best interest of efficiency in our government, and I would urge the adoption of LB 109.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You have heard the closing. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 109 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 109.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 109 is advanced. Items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 1216-1223 by title for the first time.) I have a motion from Senator Chambers to withdraw LB 1137; that will be laid over. Senator Beutler would like to announce that Senator Preister has been selected as Vice Chair of the Natural Resources Committee. Hearing notices from Transportation, Education, Retirement, and Urban Affairs, all signed by the respective chairs. And Senator Beutler announces
