SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Senator Beutler. I'll recognize the Clerk at this point for some....

CLERK: Mr. President, some items, if I may. (Read brief summary of LR 317.) New bills. (Read LB 1224-1227 by title for the first time.) I have a motion from Senator Dierks with respect to the scheduling of a bill for hearing (re LB 1193). Notice of hearing from the Banking Committee, signed by its Chair. An announcement, Reference will meet upon adjournment in Room 2102. Reference, upon adjournment in 2102. And a series of adds. Senator Bruning, to withdraw his name from (LB) 1032; Senator Will, to add to (LB) 1099; Senator Lynch, to add to (LB) 951; Senator Dwite Pedersen, to withdraw from (LB) 1114.
