CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to withdraw.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 1137 is withdrawn. We now turn to a motion to suspend the rules.

CLERK: Senator Dierks would move to suspend Rule 3, Section 13, so as to permit the scheduling of LB 1193 for public hearing on January 27, 1998.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Chair recognizes Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body. We had a little bit of a...maybe we got ahead of ourselves a little bit. We're trying to schedule a hearing for next Tuesday on 1193 and the people involved with that issue had made many contacts getting support for people to come down and testify. We had difficulties because we hadn't gotten the referencing report yet. And the referencing was done actually yesterday after we adjourned, so we need to suspend the rules in order for us to have this hearing on next Tuesday and I'd urge you support me on that issue. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator. Is there any discussion on the motion to suspend the rules? Seeing none, Senator Dierks, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before you is the motion to suspend the rules. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, to suspend the rules to permit the scheduling of a public hearing.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The rules are suspended. We now go to General File Revisor's bills and LB 892.
