SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. LB 902 does, in fact, repeal two sections of statute relating to appropriations for prison construction that were held unconstitutional by the Nebraska Supreme Court in the case of Stenberg v. Moore. They are no longer appropriate to be included in our statutes. I would move for the advancement of LB 902.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Is there any discussion? Seeing none. Senator Coordsen, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before you is the advancement of LB 902. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 902.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 902 advances. LB 903.

CLERK: (Read title.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Coordsen to open.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body. This is in the motor vehicle statutes and it does what an earlier bill did. It eliminates the phrase "this act" and replaces that with specific sections of statute which, in fact, makes all of these statutes much more readable and clearer for those who are trying to get an understanding of what they mean. I would move for the advancement of LB 903.
