CLERK: (Read title.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Coordsen to open.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. As the Clerk indicated, this bill terminates special education sections that are no longer needed because of a termination date of September 1, 1996, and with that in mind, I would recommend the advancement of 904. Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Is there any discussion? Seeing none. The...Senator Coordsen waives closing. The question before you is the advancement of LB 904. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 904.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 904 advances. Items for the record.

CLERK: Madam President, new bills. (Read LB 1250-1273 by title for the first time.) Announcements. Senator Schellpeper selected LB 1196 as his priority bill. New resolution. (Read brief summary of LR 318.) Confirmation report from Transportation Committee. Amendments to be printed: Senator Brown to (LB) 252; Senator Crosby to (LB) 800. And finally, Madam President, Senator Hartnett would like to add his name to (LB) 777; Senator Landis to (LB) 1199; Senator Jensen to (LB) 938; Senator Jensen to (LB) 1223. Senator Bruning would like to withdraw his name to LB 1114. (See pages 362-368 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. The Chair recognizes Senator Kristensen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the Legislature. I move that we adjourn until tomorrow at 9:00 a.m.
