CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 376.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 376 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, I do. New bills. (Read LB 1344-1361 by title for the first time.) In addition to those items, Mr. President, Urban Affairs Committee reports (LB) 975 to General File with amendments attached. I have a priority bill designation; Senator Thompson has selected LB 1142. Amendments by Senator Chambers to (LB) 376; Senator Jensen to (LB) 504. Enrollment and Review reports LB 109, (LB) 892, (LB) 893, (LB) 894, and (LB) 895 to Select File. Any, finally, Mr. President, a series of adds: Senator Bohlke to (LB) 1354; Senator Kiel to (LB) 1183, and (LB) 1082, and (LB) 1267; Senator Beutler to (LB) 1229; Senator Kiel to (LB) 1042; Senator Bromm to (LB) 428; Senator Will to (LB) 1268; and Senator Beutler to withdraw his name to (LB) 1228. And announcements, Mr. President. Agriculture Committee, that committee will meet today on the floor at one-thirty. That's Agriculture Committee at one-thirty. And Exec Referencing will meet upon recess or adjournment, I should say, Mr. President. That's all that I have. (See pages 386-92 of the Legislative Journal.)
