PRESIDENT ROBAK: (Microphone not immediately activated.) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Michael Clement from Bible Baptist Church in Scottsbluff, in Senator Hillman's district. Pastor Clement.
